What will I need to do?

Are you looking for a varied and flexible volunteering role, which still makes a real difference?

At Rainbows, we support around 750 babies, children, and young people across the East Midlands every year. But the annual statutory funding we receive would only keep Rainbows open for 7 weeks. That means, for the rest of the year, we rely on donations from the public.

From bucket collecting at local fundraising events, to helping run a stall at a fete you'll be inspiring others to support the amazing work we do. As a volunteer with our Community Fundraising Team, you'll help raise awareness of Rainbows across the East Midlands.

Typical activities the role could involve:

- Attending Supporter events such as car shows, concerts, fundraising events (plus various others!) by taking along a Rainbows stall or doing a bucket collection
- Attending Community activities such as fetes and local events to raise funds and awareness, whilst also engaging with potential new volunteers to attract interest
- Identifying locations for posters to help us promote Rainbows events in relevant areas
- Encouraging others to fundraise for Rainbows and pass on information to those you know!
- Researching and passing on new opportunities for our charity
- Servicing collection tins, including distributing new collection tins
